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SERVICE AGREEMENT

Updated: February 21, 2022

- I. PURPOSE: The Westwood Shores Municipal Utility District (MUD office) is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution, which could result from improper private water distribution system construction or configuration. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the restrictions, which are in place to provide this protection. The utility enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each customer must sign this agreement before THE WESTWOOD SHORES MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the Mud office will not re-establish service unless it has a signed copy of this agreement.
- II. **RESTRICTIONS**: The following unacceptable practices are prohibited by State regulations.
 - A. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a personal source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an airgap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
 - B. No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an airgap or a reduced pressure-zone (RPZ) backflow prevention device. The RPZ is to be tested upon installation and annually thereafter.
 - C. No connection, which allows water to be returned to the public drinking water supply, is permitted.
 - D. No pipe or pipe fitting should contain more than 0.25% lead (lead free) may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
 - E. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
- III. **SERVICE AGREEMENT:** The following are the terms of the service agreement between THE WESTWOOD SHORES MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT (the water system) and _____ (the customer).
 - A. The Mud office will maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the Customer and or the remises is connected to the Water System.
 - B. The Customer shall allow his property to be inspected for cross-connections and other potential contamination hazards. These inspections shall be conducted by the MUD office or its designated agent prior to initiating new water service, when there is reason to believe that cross-connections or other potential contamination hazards exist, after any major changes to the private water distribution facilities, or before water service can be established. A customer service inspection shall be conducted during the MUD's normal business hours at a cost of \$50.00 or any other certified CSI Inspector of your choice and information supplied to the MUD office.

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- C. The MUD office shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-contamination or other potential contamination hazard, which has been identified during the initial inspection the periodic reinspection.
- D. The Customer shall immediately remove or isolate any potential cross-connections or other potential contamination hazards on his premises.
- E. The Customer shall, at his expense, professionally install, assess, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the MUD office. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the MUD office.
- F. **Note to Customer**: In the event your plumbing system is closed, we strongly recommend you have a licensed plumber inspect the system to see if you need an expansion tank at your water heater. The district is not responsible for any damages due to water pressure.
- IV. ENFORCEMENT: If the Customer fails to comply with the terms of this Service Agreement, the MUD office will, at its option, either terminate service or install, assess, and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device at the service connection. The Customer is responsible for any expenses associated with the enforcement of this Agreement.
